

For Academic Year 2018-2019

1. General Scholarship Information:

One or more scholarship awards will be made for the upcoming academic year.

The number of scholarships and the amount awarded will be determined on an annual basis by the Scholarship Committee based on the number of applicants and funds available. The applicant must be enrolled in an accredited institution of higher learning and submit a completed application by 15 April 2018. The scholarship recipients will be notified no later than 15 June 2018 by written confirmation. If no adequate applications are received, the Scholarship Committee may withhold all scholarship disbursements.

Scholarship award monies must be used toward tuition, books and associated fees at an accredited institution of higher learning. The award check will be made payable to the student.

2. Scholarship Requirements

- Members of the Section Scholarship Committee are not eligible for sponsorship of this award.
- Applicants must be enrolled and in good standing at an accredited institution of higher learning. Applicants must be full-time students with a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher. An official high school or current college transcript must be provided.
- A completed and signed application must be returned and post-marked no later than 15 April 2018.
 - A 3-5 page essay supporting the theme: *How Quality Could be Applied to Improve the Educational Process.*

3. Scoring Criteria

The scholarship award will be judged and selected upon the following criteria:

- Application 10 points
- Academic Achievement 25 points
- Community Services 25 points
- Essay 40 points
- Total 100 points

**Complete all parts of the application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.*
