

Directions


From Downtown Charleston, South Carolina:

Take I-26 from Charleston toward Columbia. Remain on I-26 until Exit 209 (Ashley Phosphate Road). Exit at 209 and at the end of the exit ramp turn left onto Ashley Phosphate Road. Remain on Ashley Phosphate Road approximately 5 miles. Turn right at the traffic light onto Dorchester Road. Landmarks leading up to this intersection include an Applebee's Restaurant on the right, a Burger King on the left and a Shell/Circle K gas station and a McDonald's at the intersection. Proceed on Dorchester Road to the fourth traffic light (Wescott Boulevard) and then turn right. Proceed 1/2 mile to a circle and turn right. This will lead directly to the clubhouse.


WHY WE DO THIS EVENT?
